Dear Friends of Persian and Himalayan Cat Rescue,

It's been a crazy year, but we have risen to the challenges thanks to you, our wonderful friends and donors. While you will only see just over 20 cats listed as "adopted" on our website, that is only part of the story. We placed many more cats directly from homes before we even posted them on our site - mostly in Northern California, but sometimes beyond – making matches of needy cats with caring adopters we have come to know over the years.

The most amazing thing, however, is how many *groups* of Persian cats across the country we were called to help. Hoarders, out-of-control breeders and other sad situations caused this, and they were out in force this year. In most cases, the local groups were too overwhelmed to handle the rescued cats themselves. It takes a village.

We feel incredibly fortunate to have been able to offer support to several of these rescues due to generous donations and bequests in 2024. These gifts made it possible for PHCR to extend help to Persians and Himalayans living outside of Northern California by providing rehab and happy endings all around. Charity begins in the home – and we prioritize NorCal – but it is rewarding to be able to extend our help to as many Persians and Himalayans as possible when other groups cannot.

Here are a couple of situations where we helped pay some vet bills...

❖ Michigan

30+ Persians – in a horrible house, authorities found well over 30 Persians living in filthy conditions. Luckily, Pet Adoption Alternatives rescued all! As of now, all cats have been named for various candies because they are so sweet, and they are ADOPTED! We are proud to have contributed to paying some of their huge vet bills.

❖ Florida

20 Persians – horrific conditions and intense medical and grooming needs. AHOPE Rescue reached out to Persian rescues on Facebook, and we contributed! Many cats participated in a very successful meet and greet with adopters at a Yoga Studio!





We often say that when one's beloved pet dies, he or she "sends" the next one.




